**MOMS, YOUR HELP IS NEEDED!** Hearts & Hands still needs to fill a couple committee positions. Please take a look at these important open positions and please consider volunteering. Your skills may be exactly what is needed!

**PARADE COMMITTEE:** Two people are needed to plan the school entry into the Inwood 4th of July parade. One person can serve one year and the other person will serve two years. Typically, students ride on the float and parents walk along side the float handing out candy and/or promotional items. The float can have the school-year theme or it can be anything that promotes the school. This is your opportunity to be creative, plus there are supplies from prior years' floats that can be used again if you wish. Make this as simple or as over-the-top as you can imagine!

**PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE:** One more person is needed to fill the third position on this committee for a three year commitment – you will be trained by the veteran committee members! If you need flexibility, this may be the committee for you since the committee has funds to decide how to best promote the school to the families and staff in the school and to the community. There are a couple defined tasks, such as helping the teachers with the annual Veteran's Day program (the teachers take the lead on this!) and meeting at least once per year with a board member and teacher to strategize on promotions for the year. The Hearts & Hands officers are working to reassign or get outside help with other traditional promotion tasks, so this should be a fun and doable committee!

**FLASHDRIVE/DVD COMMITTEE:** One person is needed to fill a second position on this committee for a two-year commitment. This committee takes orders for, and prepares and distributes the picture flash drives and DVDs for purchase at the end of the school year. School staff take photos throughout the school year and this committee copies the photos onto flash drives. If there is a school play or musical, that is also copied onto a DVD. This is a flexible committee that does much of its work at the end of the school year. If you can copy elec-

tronic files, you can do this! Also, Hearts & Hands needs DVD cases for the Flashdrive/DVD Committee. If you have DVD cases that you no longer need and are in good shape, please send them to school. Thanks!
