HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING KINDERGARTEN

- 1. All children whose fifth birthday is on or before September 15, 2024, may enroll for kindergarten.
- 2. IOWA LAW REQUIRES ALL CHILDREN TO BE IMMUNIZED AGAINST CERTAIN DISEASES PRIOR TO THEIR ENTERING SCHOOL. If you as a parent are opposed to this, you must have on file a signed religious or medical exception form. (Call the Inwood Christian School Office at 753-4541 if you need this.)

The vaccine requirements are as follows:

DTP – 5 doses, one on or after age four

Polio – 4 doses, one on or after age four

MMR – 2 doses – 1st dose after 12 months, 2nd dose after age 4 Hepatitis B Series – 3 doses

Varicella (chicken pox) -2 doses after 12 months or a notation of having had the disease

- 3. All children need a Certificate of Dental Screening from their dentist and a blood test for lead.
- 4. A vision exam is highly recommended.
- 5. ALL CHILDREN MUST HAVE A COMPLETED HEALTH INFORMATION FORM AND STATE IMMUNIZATION RECORD SUBMITTED BEFORE BEING ADMITTED TO KINDERGARTEN. Please double-check with your doctor that all shot requirements have been met even if your child attended preschool and had a certificate of immunization form on file at preschool.
